

Two Student Placement / Internships

September 2024 – July 2025

<u>The Guernsey Sports Commission</u> is looking for expressions of interest for two potential placements/ internships from students studying, or who have graduated from, a sport science, coaching, teaching or related degree. The placements form a part of the Commission's work in schools, performance sport and our wider sporting community.

The placements would come with a maintenance grant of £10k. All the placements would be for one academic year with the opportunity to gain additional earning opportunities at weekends and in the holidays.

During the placement the student(s) would be supporting Sports Commission staff and teachers with the delivery of fundamental movement skills, school sport and community-based sport programmes.

In addition to the role in schools there is a choice of two distinct opportunities for students to specialise;

- Sport Science placement with performance analysis focus In previous placements our students have supported performance analysis solutions for Guernsey FC* and Guernsey Cricket overseen by qualified sport scientists. Students would also gain access to mentoring, continual professional development opportunities and formal qualifications through the Guernsey Sports Commission and its member sports.
- Motor Skills In 2023/24 the GSC will be enhancing its support to schools by increasing its capacity to
 provide motor skill interventions. In collaboration with school SENCOs, physiotherapy, occupational therapy,
 early years professionals and educational psychology students will support the programme with involvement
 and all stages of the plan, do, review process.

There is also the scope for interested students to undertake self-directed project work given the relevant stakeholders being satisfied.

Minimum requirements at commencement of the role would include a minimum UKCC2 or equivalent coaching qualification in a sport, DBS check and an in date safeguarding qualification. The Guernsey Sports Commission will be able to provide support to individuals if required in acquiring these qualifications.

 - Collating match data to include the player statistical KPI's
 - **o** Creating analysis clips for coaches and playing squad to review
 - \circ $\;$ Ad hoc reporting and data capture as identified by coaching staff
- Analysing and reporting on GPS match performance data
- Provide live match analytical support to the coaches at all Home games
- Travel with the squad to away games as and when required and provide analytical match support to the coaching staff.

The analysis software we use is considered to be the best in the business and is actually the same software used on Sky Sports and at most top professional clubs. This will undoubtedly provide the student with some exceptional experience and background knowledge that they could take further with them in the future.

Guernsey Cricket is an associate member of the International Cricket Council competing within global qualifying tournaments for T20 world cups. The organisation also has strong links with ECB and first-class counties from age groups through to the professional game which provides a range of opportunities for professional development.

Available Role

- Review match footage and provide analysis of Guernsey Cricket games to include:
 - \circ 'In game' tagging of matches to provide actionable information to the coaching team
 - \circ $\,$ Creating analysis clips for coaches and the playing squad to review
 - \circ $\;$ Linking with National Team scorer to process statistical information as required.
- Producing individual analysis packages of individual players working with first-class county age groups, academies or professional squads.
- Contribute to other sport science interventions within a model of integrated practice.
